CONFINED SPACE AWARENESS

Who Should Attend This Course:

This GHC training intervention is targeted at anyone whose work requires them to enter a confined space, this includes, managers, supervisors, operators and rescuers. The course is designed as an introduction to working safely in confined spaces therefore no pre-requisite training is needed.

A confined space is any area which is substantially enclosed and where there are risks to health and safety from hazardous substances or hazardous conditions. If you, or your employees are required to work under such conditions then regular training is recommended.

Course content:

This GHC training intervention is designed for delegates who may be required to work within confined spaces and who require the basic knowledge and skills through theoretical classroom based training. The training course has been designed to meet the Performance Criteria of the National Occupational Standards: Working in Low Risk Confined Spaces and introduces the following topics:

- The relevant legislation and guidelines.
- The classification of confined spaces.
- Confined space hazards.
- Safe working procedures.
- Equipment and tools.
- Working in teams.
- Procedures for dealing with emergencies.

Course duration: Half Day.

Assessment: Assessment is conducted through a multiple choice question paper. Delegates attaining the required pass mark of 75% will be awarded a Graham Howard Consulting certificate of achievement which is valid for three years.
