VEHICLE BANKSMAN

Who Should Attend This Course:

This course is aimed at personnel who as part of their normal day to day work are required to act as vehicle banksmen.

Course content:

Vehicle Banksman training assures that an organisation and its operators work alongside with the relevant legal requirements. It is designed to help reduce damaging accidents when carrying out vehicle manoeuvres. Almost a quarter of all vehicle-based fatalities that occur are due to a reversing vehicles at work.

On successful completion of this course delegates will be qualified to bank any category of vehicle up to and including LGV/HGV articulated lorry. Bank vehicles on any site in the UK with permission of the person responsible for site Health and Safety.

The client is responsible for supplying all equipment and PPE. Please be sure that the facilities available on site are suitable for training. Basic comfort and welfare facilities must also be provided.

Minimum PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Safety Footwear - All delegates must wear safety footwear for the duration of the practical training. Delegates will not be allowed to participate in training without safety footwear. Hi Vis coat, hard hat: Must be available for the practical assessment. Only one of each item need be available and can be rotated between delegates as they are only required during the practical assessment.

It does not qualify delegates to instruct or supervise others who have not received formal training as a vehicle banksman.

Course duration: Two to three hours.

Assessment:

Assessment is conducted through a multiple choice question paper and practical assessment. Delegates attaining the required pass mark of 75% and passing the practical assessment will be awarded a Graham Howard Consulting certificate of achievement which is valid for three years.
