## LEVEL 3 AWARD PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID AT WORK (RQF)

This course is ideal for learners wishing to become paediatric first aiders in a workplace with the responsibility for the welfare of infants and children. The course is aligned with the paediatric first aid syllabus within the Early Years Foundation Stage and is valid for a period of three years after which delegates must retake the course. In addition, annual refresher training is strongly recommended.

Subjects covered include:

- The roles and responsibilities of a paediatric first aider.
- How to provide first aid to an infant or child who is unresponsive
- How to administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator.
- How to administer first aid to an infant or child who is choking, has a fracture or other conditions, such as burns, electric shock and sudden poisoning.
